What is the Catholic Inquiry? The Inquiry is an opportunity to investigate Catholicism, especially for those who are not already Catholic. It is a process of discovery and self-reflection in which people explore the meaning of Christ in their lives, and how that works within the Catholic Faith.

Meetings are on most Tuesday evenings, from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm, in the Hospitality Room (accessed through Community Center patio doors). If you wish to become Catholic and cannot make Tuesday evenings, please call us.

If you wish to be baptized:

If you are non-baptized and wish to become Catholic, you can continue with a process that will culminate at Easter. You will celebrate the "sacraments of initiation": baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist.

If you have already been baptized and wish to become Catholic:

If you have been baptized and well initiated into Christianity through other denominations, you can either celebrate Catholic initiation after several months or at Easter. You will celebrate a profession of faith and the sacraments of confirmation and Eucharist.
